to miss the mark (same in Greek) Stepping from the Path (derekh) Genesis 4



avah/iniquity

to be twisted, crooked, distorted Distorting the Path (derekh) Genesis 15



pesh'a/transgression

to break a covenant or agreement (Modern Hebrew: crime) Abandoning the Path (derekh) Genesis 31

philology


the branch of knowledge that deals with the structure, historical development, and relationships of a language or languages.
